## **Rope by Patrick Hamilton** Medway Little Theatre, 5th-14th April 2018

*Rope* is one of the true classics of the suspense genre. Written by Patrick Hamilton (*Gaslight, Twenty Thousand Streets Under The Sky*) in 1929, and filmed by the BBC in 1939, by ITV in 1957, by Australian TV in 1959, and by Alfred Hitchcock in 1948, its appeal has endured to this day.

Loosely based on the true story of the kidnap and murder of teenager Robert Franks by Leopold and Loeb, two wealthy students at the University of Chicago, in May 1924, and pastiched, parodied, and performed ever since, Hamilton's play operates like a murder mystery in reverse. The culprits are revealed at the very beginning of the play, and the thrills derive from teasing the audience as to whether or not they will be found out or get away with the heinous crime.
