Penelope Wilton, Juliet Stevenson, Glenn Close, and Thandiwe Newton, among many other luminaries of the stage and screen, have all portrayed Paulina, the protagonist of this thrilling play. We hope you enjoy this play that will thrill, surprise, and make you think.
